Visitors come to Buffalo National River for a variety of reasons – floating, swimming, camping, hiking, horseback riding, watching wildlife or simply renewing spirits in one of the cabins located along the river. Among the cabins available for visitors are the Buffalo Point cabins.

In the 1930s during the Great Depression, Franklin Delano Roosevelt formed the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). Young men between the ages of 18 and 25 who were out of work went to national and state parks all around the country, building structures that are still standing today.

Some of the finest work of the CCC can be found at Buffalo Point along the Buffalo National River. The cabins at Buffalo Point were built in the late 1930s, along with the furniture in the cabins. Sadly, time has taken a toll on the caned furniture in the cabins.
